Position in the organisation

Scope of job

You will understand and support teams on the planning, delivery and execution of projects and implications for funding as well as developing business cases and bids and reviewing performance. You will assist in ensuring compliance with the donor financial requirements and support donor audits.

- 6. Driving business strategy

Restricted finance reporting and analysis

- 1. Work across the restricted income teams to develop the financial aspect of new bids and to review and evaluate new funding and income opportunities
- 2. Highlight risks and opportunities for existing and potential funds
- 3. Develop strong relationships with donor finance teams
- 4. Closely monitor restricted fund budgets

- 5. Ensure high quality and timely financial reporting to donors
- 6. Ensure compliance with the financial requirements as specified in donor contracts to ensure strong financial management
- 7. Assist in planning and execution of donor audits

Financial Management

- Review, develop and implement effective financial monitoring performance reporting and analysis, working across the organisation to ensure that right management information is available to inform project management decisions in real time
- Develop and implement commercial finance training for teams
- Drive a continuous improvement culture across systems, processes and reporting
